The European Pet Food Industry Federation has made some nutritional guidelines for complete and complementary pet food for cats and dogs.

FEDIAF Guideline

- It should be formulated to take account of current nutritional knowledge.
- If nutrient levels are outside the levels stated in the guide, manufacturers should be able to prove that the product provides adequate and safe intakes of all required nutrients.
- Each family of products should be validated by chemical analysis of the finished product.
- Change in the formulation or processing a complete re-analysis is required.
- Regular analyses to ensure uniformity of product over time
